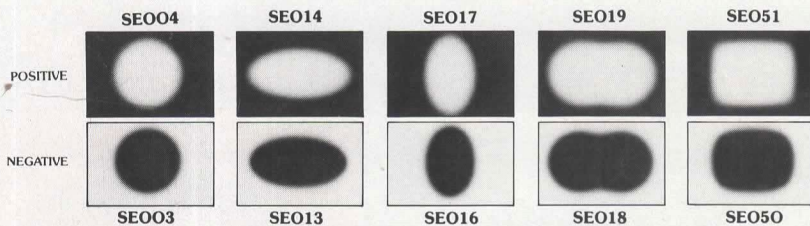

POSITIVE AND NEGATIVES SUPERIMPOSED IMAGES

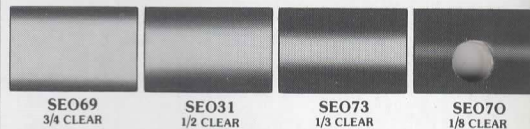

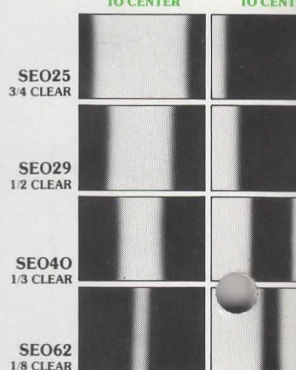

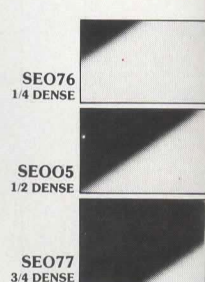

PLEASE NOTE:

- Soft-Edge Masks are best known for developing two-screen center overlap panoramas. However, using this chart, one can see how they can be effectively used with single-screen productions.
- It is difficult to determine exactly where a soft-edge starts and stops; therefore, all fraction sizes are given as approximate reference to size of opening.

- All masks are shot in register for use in peg registered mounts, but may be punched using the VR system and mounted in VR mounts (see pages 32-36).
- To achieve certain effects, Wess Soft-Edge Masks may be flipped, resulting in mirror image left to right or top to bottom.
