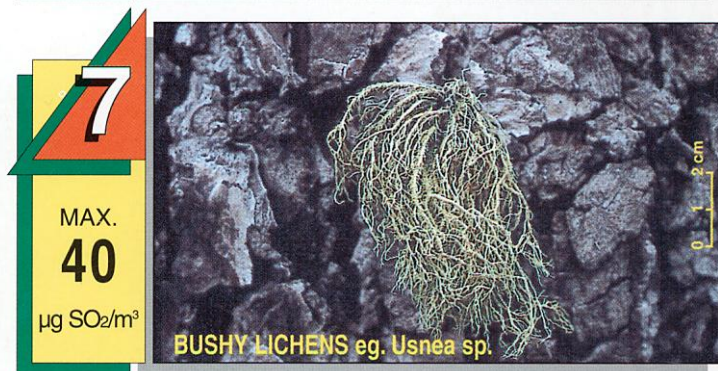
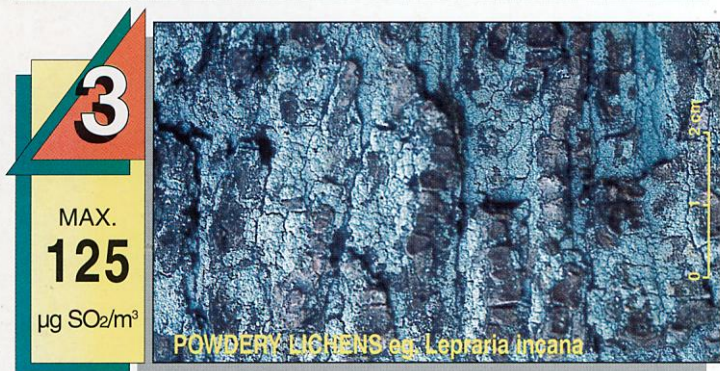
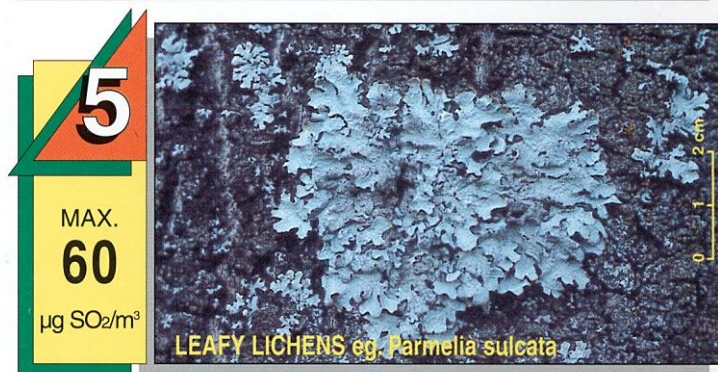
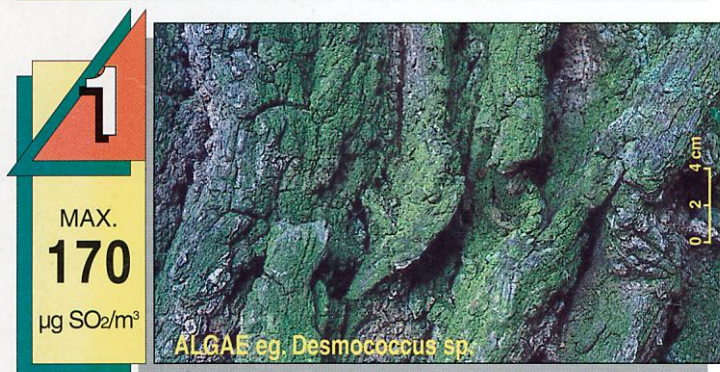
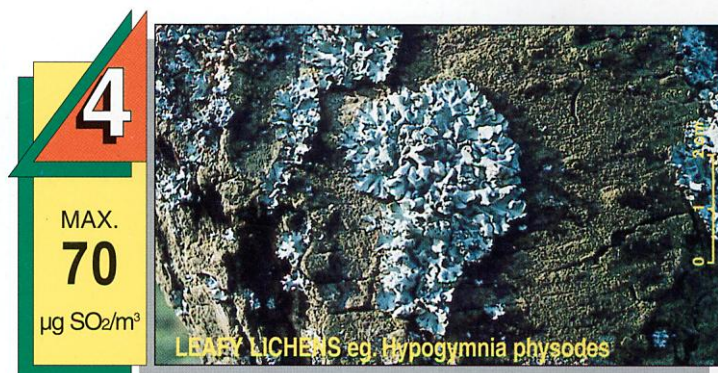
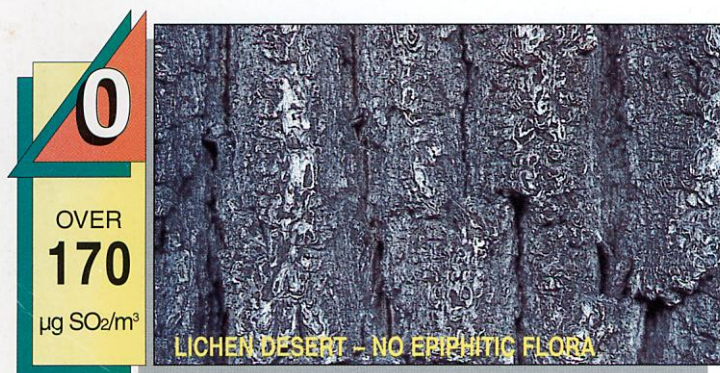


The Lichen Scale

How to use the lichen scale ?

- ☐ Look at the pictures of lichens and algae, pay attention to shape, size and colour
- ☐ Start searching the area for lichens on the trees.
- ☐ Compare the lichens you have found with those in the pictures.
- ☐ Read SO_2 concentration ($\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ atmospheric air) at which the most sensitive lichens you have found occur, and the number of the air pollution zone.
- ☐ Repeat the observation of lichens on other trees growing nearby – your evaluation of air pollution will be more accurate.
